- 27 **Gewürztraminer Grand Crû 'Froehn', 2010** FRANCE £60.00
Edmond Rentz
One of the most unique wines in the world, with a fruit-packed taste that's jaw droppingly powerful. Explosive aromas of spice and lychees, full bodied with a long finish.
- 28 **Puligny-Montrachet, 2007** FRANCE £85.00
Michel Picard
Citrus, vanilla and hazelnut aromas on the nose, with an exceptionally well balanced palate. There are slightly exotic fruit notes intermingled with classic orchard fruit, well integrated oak and a fine, persistent finish.
- 29 **Batard-Montrachet Grand Crû, 2004** FRANCE £275.00
Louis Latour
Toasty, creamy and intense on the nose, with some mineral notes. The palate is lively, fresh and minerally with good acid and precision. Bold and focused with complex herby notes.

FINE RED

- 30 **Côte de Beaune 'Les Longes', 2003** FRANCE £120.00
Loïs Dufouleur
The best vintage in a decade from this domaine. 15 consecutive days of temperatures in excess of 40 degrees, producing a small yield and the earliest ever vintage. "Pot pourri" nose, brambley, complex and more weight than you would expect, performs well above it's station.
- 31 **Nuits-St-George 1^{er} Crû, 2007** FRANCE £115.00
Michel Picard
Deep mahogany-red colour reveals a complex bouquet of dried fruits and earthy characters. Good Pinot Noir fruit, with a very fine tannin structure
- 32 **Château la Croix St. Georges, 2002** FRANCE £85.00
Pomerol, Bordeaux
Scented wood spices with soft supple fruits with a gentle and succulent basket of black and red fruits. Fresh and bright wine.
- 33 **Château Rauzan Ségla 2^{eme} Grand Crû Classé, 1986** FRANCE £320.00
Margaux, Bordeaux
Thick and complex with notes of roses, black fruits and undergrowth. Dense and rustic, blackcurrant focused
- 34 **Château Mouton Rothschild 1^{er} Grand Crû Classé, 1995** FRANCE £760.00
Pauillac, Bordeaux
Reluctant aromas of cassis, truffles, coffee, liquorice, and spice. In the mouth, the wine is "great stuff," with superb density, a full-bodied personality, rich mid-palate, and a layered, profound finish.
- 35 **Shiraz, 1999** AUSTRALIA £160.00
Eileen Hardy
Dark, dense, brooding. Intensely black fruited, lifted by Herbs de Provence notes. Smoky, gorgeous, juicy, full-bodied but balanced by lively acidity and textured tannins. Lovely accent of pepper and spice.
- 36 **Penfold's Grange, 1985** AUSTRALIA £750.00
Deep crimson, intense plum, camomile, violet and earthy aromas. An elegantly structured wine with blackberry, black olive and plum flavours, good sweetness and firm savoury tannins.
