- N.V. Canard-Duchêne “Cuvée Leonie” Brut, Reims, Champagne 12%** £55
50% Pinot Noir, 25% Pinot Meunier, 25% Chardonnay, bright gold, ripe orchard and peach fruits on the nose, floral, buttery brioche, fine mousse, zesty acidity, delicious long dry finish.
- N.V. Charles VII Rosé, Brut, Reims, Champagne 12%** £75
Smooth Rosé Charles VII is composed of 59% of Chardonnay, 21% of Pinot Noir, and 20% of Pinot Meunier, reserved wines predominantly Pinot Noir from The Montagne de Reims, fresh and fruity.
- 2009 Larmandier-Bernier 1er Cru “Terre de Vertus” Blanc de Blancs, Extra Brut 12.5%** £89
A Biodynamic coming from a single terroir 100 % Chardonnay and single vintage, 2009 is one of the finest expressions of champagne from Vertus. Aged on the lees for at least 4 years, this spectacular champagne has delicious aromas of honey, praline, toasted brioche and white peach. On the palate, tiny persistent bubbles linger impressively, paving the way for a creamy, rich finish.
- N.V. Billecart-Salmon Brut Rosé, Mareuil-sur-Ay, Champagne 12%** £99
A pale pink in colour with golden hints, fine delicate bubbles, leading to a persistent mousse. The bouquet is fine and elegant, with ripe strawberries, raspberries and fresh bread. On the palate, it is refined, with prominent fruit flavours, and a long, fresh finish.
- 2005 Bollinger “Grande Année” Brut, Ay Marne, Champagne 12%** £125
Delicate golden hay, complex aromas of honey, hazelnuts and rich fruits, fresh and confit. Its mouthfeel is supple, full and long.
- 2006 Dom Pérignon Brut, Epernay, Champagne 12.5%** £180
Wonderfully vivid and rich sensory experience: from the nose-filling aromas, all the way to the huge finish. Smoke, spices, saffron, sweet yellow pepper, mustard seed and rainwater. Very impressive that it should be so vibrant at such a young age. The palate is creamy and dense, yet fresh and precise, with a composed, smooth mousse.

Cristal “The wine of Tsars”, Made by 60% Pinot Noir and 40% Chardonnay, is made with a great balance of freshness and aging. Ripe yellow fruits, aromas of citrus fruits and toast, honeyed flavours, precise minerality, pure and silky, powerful and expressive, persistent finish.

Traditional Method (the same method used to make Champagne) using 20 year Chenin Blanc old vines planted on limestone-clay soils, crisp acidity, complex, biscuity character and fine, persistent bubbles.

NV Hambledon Vineyards Classic Cuvee Brut, Hampshire, England 12% £48

Blend of 60% Chardonnay, 20% Pinot Noir, 20% Pinot Meunier.

Aromas of sweet flowers, sourdough, green plums, poached apples, fresh, lively acidity.

NV Hambledon Vineyards Classic Cuvee Rose, Hampshire, England 12% £52

Gold Medal at the 2016 International Wine Challenge.

Blend of Carriante and Catarrato, tropical fruits, pear, white peach, citrusy, refreshing flinty minerality.
- 2015 Sancerre "Les Chasseignes" Domaine Riffault, Loire, France 13%** £42
Clean green apple and grapefruit, deep flinty, limestone minerality, great expression of the terroir.

White Wine

2015 Cotes du Rhone Blanc "Bouquet des Garriges", Clos du Caillou, Rhone, France 13.5% £42

Blend of Pink Clairette, Grenache Blanc, Viognier and Bourboulec.

Elegant nose of white fruit, white flowers, honey, quince, poached apples, peach, fresh acidity, fruity finish.

2014 Pernand-Vergelesses "Les Belles Filles" Sylvain Loichet, Burgundy 13.5% £48

Domaine Sylvain Loichet is situated in the heart of Burgundy in Chorey-les-Beaune.

Notes of white fruit, honeysuckle, white flowers, good concentration, rich and complex, harmonious freshness, great minerality, good persistent finish.

2014 Chablis 1er Cru Montmains, Domaine Gerard Duplessis, Burgundy 12.5% £51

Displays minerality on the nose, green stone fruit, crisp acidity, spicy, moderate depth, classy.

2014 Ayze "Les Alpes" Vin de Savoie, Domaine Belluard, Biodynamic 12% £58

From a little village Ayze in the Haute-Savoie situated in the heart of the valley of the Arve between Geneva and Chamonix Mont-Blanc. Vineyards have been established here since the 13th century. The vines are 600m high,. Patrick and Dominique Belluard are biodynamic makers and make use of the virtually unique ancient Gringet grape. A clear and crystalline pale-straw in the glass. Look for aromas of white flowers and citrus edged white peach with a twist of aniseed to finish.

2010 Bargylus Blanc, Deir Touma Lattaquié, Saadé Family, Syria 13.5% £65

This is the last bottling estate in Syria. A complex wine, which is typically Mediterranean in style from the estate's 20 hectares of beautiful vineyards on ancient soils, vines planted up 900m high altitude. Bargylus Blanc is full bodied, rich, lovely vibrant acidity and clean mineral backbone but the maturity of the wine give more richness.

2014 Riesling Grand Cru "Schlossberg" Albert Mann, Wettolsheim Alsace, France 13% £70

Aromas of fennel, grapefruit, honeydew melon, refreshing mouth watering in the palate, delicate minerality, this is a serious Riesling with length and complexity.
